Report of achievements

Madhya Pradesh Bhoj Open University has been consistent in its vision and has many achievements in line with each of its mission statements.

Mission:

- 1. To build an integrated open education system enabling the learners to attain their career and social and national goals.
 - The curricula are reviewed periodically by statutory bodies and revised as per need.
 The PPR developed as per the NEP directives specify course and programme outcomes.
 - Each of our programs is designed as per the prescribed PPR format instructed by UGC. Our SLMs are designed by experts and reviewed periodically by the academic council for relevance.
 - The academic progress of the students is tracked with the help of assignments and evaluation through formal examinations.

2. To emerge as a knowledge centre through ICT facilities in education delivery processes and academic governance.

- The admission process has been digitized. Moist of the self-learning materials are available in e-format. There are multiple media of instruction.
- Student support is the heart of open education system. With the help of this support portal, learners can access all information related to their academic needs. It comprises academic information like admission, programme details, fee details, list of study learning centers, list of regional centers, contact classes, practical examination, term and examination, result declaration, as well as student helpdesk
- The university has a well-equipped, well-lit and well-ventilated library with 24,518 books of various subjects and is the backbone of the University. The library has 421 research papers on various subjects. The library is partially automated, and the full automation plan is on the anvil.




- The LMS developed by the Department of Higher Education, Madhya Pradesh, is also made available for the students of the University. The University has been subscribing to DELNET for the last three years, and it is also available for students in the library. It is upgraded with an Internet facility for the students to explore new horizons during their stay in the institute. Apart from this, a Digital library with 5 PCs is also available in the library for the benefit of the students, with e-books, e-resources and e-Journals as per the AICTE norms. The Database and routine work is performed with the help of 'e-Granthalaya'. Many free research databases and software can also be accessed by the learners and faculty.
- The University has developed 277 Video Lectures and 552 Audio Lectures, all of which are available on YouTube for the students.

3. To attain the global standards of academic practices through research, institutional collaborations and need-based training programs.

The institution has entered into MoUs with various organizations. Their list is given below. These collaborations have helped the University grow in statute and achieve its vision of excellence.




4. To make learners competitive and socially responsible citizens by incorporation of humanistic values and vocational skills in academic programs/curriculum.

As part of our social commitment, we have a social responsibility cell under which many activities are conducted. The University has adopted 15 villages under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan, conducted detailed awareness programmes on sickle cell anaemia and other burning social issues. The University has always been committed to sustainable development, and the campus has around 25000 trees and a vibrant ecosystem.

5. To ensure inclusive and equitable quality higher education and promote lifelong learning opportunities to all sections of society.

- SLMs are available in hard and soft formats. The hard copies are sent to the learner, and the soft copy of the SLM is available on the University website. The *e-PG paathshaala* and *swayam* platforms are excellent avenues for references. *Bhoj Darshan* services are open to all students to learn online at their pace and convenience. The *Bhojvani* service is an internet-based audio tutorial designed to reach out to students in far and remote areas.
- We have 11 regional centres spanning the entire geographic area of Madhya Pradesh, and the students can come over to the study centres for doubt clearance during the time specified by the University.
- Overcoming the language barrier, the University has SLMs in dual languages of Hindi and English for the facilities of those students who are from the non-Hindi belt. All courses offered by the University are bilingual except those in the Hindi language.
- Jail inmates have taken admission, pursued their studies, and passed the examination
 as well. The deaf and dumb learners from the Centre at Indore under the Department
 of Social Justice and Empowerment of Disabled are pursuing a DCA degree and
 passing the exam as well.
- Madhya Pradesh Bhoj Open University's experiment to disseminate higher education via state-owned television channels is an innovative approach to reaching the unreached population. This initiative aims to provide quality education to those with limited access to traditional modes of higher education, such as attending physical classes on college campuses.



• Utilizing various audio and video programs enables students to receive lectures and engage in discussions from the comfort of their own homes. The program's primary goal is to make education accessible to those living in remote areas with limited educational resources. This initiative is an excellent example of the effective use of technology to address social inequalities and bridge the education gap.
