

MADHYA PRADESH BHOJ (OPEN) UNIVERSITY ORDINANCE No. 30 M.SC. (IT) proposed ordinance for master degree in (information technology)

1. TITLE

The title of the course shall be **M.Sc. in Information Technology** and will be run in the Department of Department of Computers, Computational Mathematics and Communication, M.P. Bhoj (Open) University, Bhopal on regular basis under self-supporting scheme, and will be a full time programme.

2. DURATION OF THE COURSE

The duration of M.Sc. (Information Technology) course shall extend over four semester spread over two academic years. The number of seats will normally be limited to twenty. Five additional seats can be allotted to sponsored candidates from Government Institutions and industries. Five more payment seats can be provided to Non Resident Indians (NRIs)/NRI sponsored/foreign national. The reservations for SC/ST/OBC and others will be applicable as per University rules.

3. ELIGIBILITY

a) Every candidate seeking admission to M. Sc. (Information Technology) shall have passed Bachelor's degree with at least 50% marks in theory papers and in second division in aggregate and with a combination of any two of the following subjects at degree level :

- 1. Computer Science/Computer Engineering
- 2. Electronics
- 3. Mathematics
- 4. Physics.

A person holding Bachelor's degree in Engineering from any discipline shall also be eligible.

b) Candidates who have not obtained a Bachelor's Degree at the time of application but are appearing in the final year of a degree examination during the year of admission may also apply. However, such candidates shall be considered provisionally and they will have to produce evidence of becoming eligible by a specified date notified by the University.

c) Students admitted to the course shall not be allowed to join any of the course of study or appear in any other examination.



4. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Subject to the requirement of admission as indicated above any candidate seeking admission to the programme shall apply in the prescribed form along with necessary documents, as may be indicated by a specified date. The admission to program shall be from the merit list based on

- a) Entrance test with an interview
- b) The theory marks of graduation (50 50 weightage)

Further weightage can be given for the outstanding national level achievement of the candidates. Candidates shall be required to pay fee for the entrance test notified by the university.

5. ADMISSION FEE, TUITION FEE AND EXAMINATION FEE ETC.

A student admitted to the program shall pay the admission fee, tuition fee, laboratory fee, etc.
