ORDINANCE No. 36

Ordinance for the Course of M.B.A. (Material Management) MBA (MM) (Three Years duration)

(Distance Mode)

The course was formerly nomenclatured as M.B.A. in Material Management (MBAMM). The new nomenclature is in accordance with UGC guidelines.

The ordinance provides for admission, examination and other incidental matters related to MBAMM Course of three year duration, offered by the Department of Management of the University through Distance Mode.

1. The MBAMM Course shall be of three years duration.
2. The valuation of the student offering the course shall be conducted in two steps viz. (i) Term End Examination (Called University Main Examination) (ii) Assignments.
3. Term End Examination, Courses and other condition shall be governed by the ordinance No. 5
4. The execution of MBA (MM) course offered by the Department shall be governed by the rules and regulations as recommended and framed by the Academic Council of the University time to time. The Academic Council shall frame the rules and regulations for -
 - (a) Eligibility criteria for admission to the course.
 - (b) Course structure and its detailed syllabi
 - (c) Mode of assignments and their valuation for the course.
 - (d) Main project and its valuation.
 - (e) Modality for contact programme(s) for the course and
 - (f) Any other matter related to the academic growth and utility of the course.
5. In the final year of the course there shall be a project of 200 marks.
6. The minimum pass marks in assignments, in university main examination and in the total of assignment plus university main examination for each paper separately shall be 40%, 30% and 40% respectively.
7. A candidate failing in not more than two papers shall be allowed to appear in supplementary examination (distance mode), as conducted by the University. If he/she fails, he/she shall be declared fail and shall be governed by clause (9) below.

8. A candidate failing in more than two papers shall be declared fail. He/she shall be required to appear in all the components (assignments and University Main Examination) of all the papers of the course of the respective year during the next or subsequent examination as conducted by the University.
9. A candidate seeking admission to any of the courses offered by this institute shall have to ensure that he/she shall not simultaneously register/enroll himself/herself for any other course offered by this university or any other university. If such an information is revealed at any point of time, the candidature of the student shall be cancelled.
10. The candidate shall be awarded division on the basis of marks secured in aggregate as follows :

First Division	-	60% and above.
Second Division	-	50% and above but less than 60%
Third Division	-	40% and above but less than 50%.
