ORDINANCE No. 38

POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN CHEMO INFORMATICS (PGDCI)

The duration of Post Graduate Diploma in Chemo Informatics (PGDCI) Programme shall be one year.

A candidate who has passed B.Sc in Biology/Chemistry and Maths or equivalent relevant examination of any recognised University or equivalent shall be eligible for admission.

Every candidate for the Post Graduate Diploma in Chemo Informatics Examination shall have to offer 8 compulsory courses depending on students' interests. The detailed syllabus is formulated by the Academic Council and shall be as per modification by the Council from time to time.

For one year session in examination every course/subject will have one paper is carrying a maximum of 100 marks (including 30 marks for sessionals in each paper) and one Project Work of 100 marks based on field work/industrial training.

For continuous study and assessment, there will be two tutorial mark assignments for the session for each course. The higher of the scores of these assignments will be taken into account for each course per session.

In order to pass in any session of the programme, the examinee must obtain a minimum of 40% of total marks for each course in the session end examination.

The candidates, who pass in each of the courses will qualify for the award of PGDCI in determining the result of the entire programme aggregate of performance of the students. The students securing 60% or more marks will be placed in first Division, those securing

50% or more but less than 60% will be placed in second Division and those securing 40% or more but less than 50% in third Division.

There shall be a supplementary examination giving only one chance to candidates who fail in only one course/paper.

The delivery of the programme consists of print study materials, audio/video support, assignments, contact classes, library consultation, etc. A minimum of 60% of attendance in contact classes, submission of assignments will be necessary condition for the eligibility of the candidate, to appear in session end examination.
