Post Graduate Diploma in Heritage Management

Objective : The objective of this programme is to provide professional skill to the students who are interested in chalking out a career in the field of Heritage Management, Musicology and Museum Conservation and preservation of national heritage, structural conservation, archaeological photography and Historical and Cultural Journalism.

Besides, regular jobs in museums, the student would be capable of handling project works in government and non-government organizations. Since there is a dearth in government jobs, the student would be able to develop his own private conservation lab after completing this programme. The student would be capable of giving legal advise to various firms and organizations regarding antiquarian laws.

Duration of the Programme : One year.

Eligibility : Graduation in any discipline.

Course Content : There would be six theory papers and one practical.

Course 1	:	Concept, Policy & Management
Course 2	:	Biodiversity, Heritage laws and Organizations
Course 3	:	Archaeology and Heritage Management.
Course 4	:	Museums & Conservation of Cultural Property.
Course 5	:	Art Heritage and Structural Conservation.
Course 6	:	Living traditions
Course 7	:	Making of Heritage Plans and Practicals involving Training in Conservation and Basic Computer Applications, Vivavoce.

Contact Classes: Two contact classes of 15 days each.

Exam Structure : The examination would involve both internal assessment as well as term end assessment. The internal assessment would be 30%, and the term end assessment would be 70% i.e. an aggregate of 100 marks for each paper.
