ORDINANCE No. 63 Diploma in Computer Application (DCA)

Objectives:

- To educate number of people about computer.
- To extend ultra modern technology to the rural and remote areas of the state for modernization.
- To provide equality of opportunities for learning computer of higher quality through Gujarati Medium.
- To develop educated human resources through computer education in rural areas.
- To provide opportunity of computer education to the present day in service employees employed in public and private sectors.

Eligibility: 10 + 2 or equivalent or not less than 10th standard under the special project mode.

Duration of the Course: Minimum **One year**

Fees of the Course : To be decided by the University

Structure of the Course : The course will comprise of a total of eight papers of which six papers are theoretical in nature and two papers pertains to laboratory work.

Evaluation:

- Students will be allowed to appear in the term end examination at the end of the period of six months.
- If he/she fails in the term end examination he/she will be allowed to be appear in the term end examination within the period of two years.
- The students failing to complete his course successfully within two years he/she will have to register his/her name again and pay the prescribed amount of fees.
- Term end examination can evaluate the students through computer and/or through any person.

Standard of Success: Every student is expected to get through the term end examination with 40% marks in total or decided by the university.
